Registration Update: Included in this mailer is your personalized Registration Update letter. Please complete the online update no later than Wednesday, August 16th. Students who do not complete this requirement will NOT be enrolled in the Early College Alliance for the 2023-2024 school year.

Upcoming dates to remember

Wednesday, August 16th: Deadline for Registration Update to be completed. See enclosed letter for details.

Monday, August 21st, 6-8pm: Back to School Kickoff. MANDATORY for Returning Students grades 11 and up and ONE parent/guardian - Student Center Ballroom.

Tuesday, August 22nd, 8:30am - 12:30pm: CORE Challenge Day (for ALL students). This is an orientation day where students will meet other classmates of all grade levels.

Wednesday, August 23rd, 8:30am-12:30pm. CAMP-US Orientation for <u>Returning Academy Students (& new/incoming</u> <u>students ONLY</u>). Returning Academy students should bring a backpack/book bag to carry their materials.

Monday, August 28th: First day of EMU classes ONLY -- NO ECA classes. (NOTE: This is before Labor Day)

Tuesday, August 29th: First day of ECA classes - Full day of school. (NOTE: This is before Labor Day).

Friday, September 1, and Monday, September 4. No School (ECA or EMU) for Labor Day.

Thursday, September 7, 6pm - 8pm: Curriculum Night. Late Start for ECA & Academy Classes to accommodate Curriculum Night; details TBA. Mandatory meeting for parents/guardians of <u>new/incoming & Returning Academy</u> <u>students ONLY</u>.

Friday, September 8th -- First Early Release Day for ECA & Academy classes. Early Release for these classes will take place on most Fridays.

Fall '23 ECA Class Schedules/Book Pickup

If you are in 11th grade and up, ECA schedules will be distributed during CORE Challenge Day (as well as books/materials for ECA classes only). If you are Returning Academy, you will receive your ECA schedule (as well as books/materials) on Camp-Us - 8/23. If you have an EMU class, please log in to your **my.emich** account for your class schedule and room locations.

EMU Only (& Hybrid) Schedule Book Pickup

PLEASE NOTE: Returning Academy will receive their ECA books/materials on Camp-Us - 8/23.

Returning Students in 11th and 12th grade with ECA classes (hybrid schedule)

You will pick up your ECA books directly after the <u>CORE Challenge Day</u> event, on August 22. Please note that you WILL NOT pick up any EMU class books at this time.

All Students in EMU Classes - (Including Hybrid)

Sign-up slots will be available for August 24 & 25 in King 122. <u>All students who are in EMU classes will sign up for a slot to</u> <u>pick up books</u>. Watch for an email from Ms. McKague to grab a slot on Sign-Up Genius. If you are unable to make either of these days, you can come to Ms. McKague's drop-in hours the following week when classes start.

Please understand that once classes start, you are in the Procrastinators Line of Shame. Expect long wait times!

Technology Needs for Students

All ECA students, enrolled in either ECA and/or EMU classes, should plan to have a laptop computer for use in all of their classes. Students are welcome to bring their own device (i.e. Macbook, PC laptop, or Chromebook; tablets are acceptable but may have some limitations to their use) or to check out a Chromebook from ECA.

There is no cost to check out a school Chromebook, but we do recommend that students purchase insurance to cover accidental damage or replacement of their school Chromebook (not including replacement chargers) for \$30. If students choose not to insure their school devices, they accept responsibility for the cost of any repairs or replacement needed (see this list of common repair costs: http://bit.ly/DeviceRepairCosts)

Our device checkout (rollout) event is scheduled for **Wednesday, August 23 during Camp-Us**. REC/IM Opt-Out Form

The recently renovated Rec/IM Facility offers basketball, volleyball, and racquetball courts, group fitness studio, fitness machines, two pools, an indoor track, billiards and gaming, and more. If you have any EMU classes on your fall schedule, EMU will add a **\$55 Rec/IM Fee** to your bill. You are responsible for paying this bill, but you can opt out if you do not wish to utilize the facilities. The automatic Rec/IM Fee will be removed from the student account of those students enrolled in at least one EMU Course during the Fall 2023 semester IF you complete and submit the form (scan QR code \rightarrow). Students not enrolled in an EMU course should not complete the form.



Students with EMU classes need to email the completed and signed form to <u>ebill@emich.edu</u> by September 7th.

EMU Parking Permit

Are you in need of a parking pass for the Fall 2023 semester? Via ParkEMU, Fall parking permits are \$206 per semester and will be available for sale starting August 14th. Permits can only be purchased online at **www.parkemu.com** and you will need to log in with your EMU ID. ECA Parent/Guardian Commitment

Parents and guardians are a vital part of the ECA community. There are many opportunities for parent/guardian involvement, and the expectation is that families will contribute their time, talent, and/or resources throughout the school year. The following is a guideline for the minimum expected level of commitment:

- 3 hours of volunteering/semester (6 hours/year)
- 3 ECA Pi meetings/semester (6 meetings/year)
- \$25 in check, cash, or donations/semester (\$50/year, payable to ECA PI)
